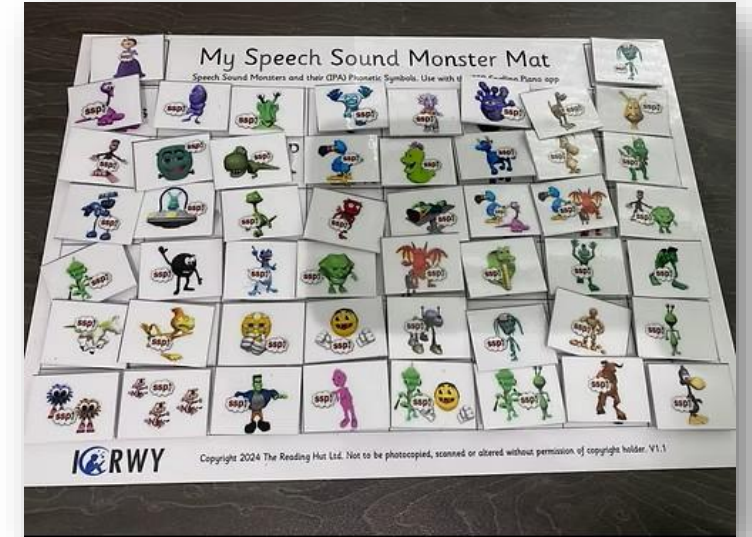
When learning the new word

and blend.
